Know all men by these presents that Ord L. Irwin, Pearl L. Walker and Austin Walker, her husband and Earl L. Irwin, of Skamania County State of Washington, in consideration of twenty two hundred (\$2200.00) Dollars to them paid by Paul J. Vial, of Portland Multnomah County state of Oregon have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Paul J. Vial, his heirs and assigns all the following bounded and described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington:
