

and also reserving the right for said Oregon Lumber Company to the use for a reasonable time of the flume running across portion of said lands for the purpose of fluming to the Columbia River any wood or poles belonging to said Oregon Lumber Company upon said premises - and the right to enter without let or hindrance upon of said premises for a reasonable time - for the purpose of fluming said wood or poles and removing said machinery, tools, brick and iron. It being the intention of this instrument to release and quit-claim unto the said D. A. McFarlane an undivided one sixth of all that certain real estate - with said reservation fully excepted and reserved as contained in a certain Deed of quit-claim executed by said Oregon Lumber Company to Henderson and Short - dated March 15th 1902 - duly acknowledged and recorded in Deed Records of Skamania County, Washington in Book "H" at page 72 - reference is to which is hereby made and the said Deed is made a part hereof for all the purposes hereof. Of the above consideration the sum of \$400.00 is paid in cash - and for the balance - \$551.98 - the said D. A. McFarlane hereby assumes and agrees to pay off and discharge and undivided one sixth part (or half of the obligation of said J. D. Casey) of a certain purchase price mortgage on said land of \$331.90 and interest from the date thereof - executed by the grantors of the Deed to said J. D. Casey - to wit: - John Leland Henderson and wife and J. F. Short and wife to and in favor of the Oregon Lumber Company - as aforesaid. To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining to the said D. A. McFarlane - and to his heirs and assigns forever.
