

Fred Miller to Ernst B. Krueger.  
Mining Deed.

This Indenture, made the 24th day of July, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety seven, between Fred Miller, unmarried, of Lewis County and State of Washington, the party of the first part, and Ernst B. Krueger, of the City of Spokane, State of Washington, the party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five and  $\frac{no}{100}$  Dollars, (\$75.00) and other valuable considerations, said Seventy five and  $\frac{no}{100}$  Dollars, - lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, convey and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest, estate, claim and demands, of the said party of the first part, of, in and to those certain portions, claims and mining rights, titles and properties on certain ledges, veins, lodes or deposits of quartz and other rock in place, containing precious metals of Gold, Silver and other metals, and which said certain portions, claims and mining rights and properties are now held by the said party of the first part by virtue of locations made thereon under the Mining Laws of the United States of America, and the Laws of the State of Washington, situated in the St. Helens Mining District, State of Washington, and now of Record in the Records of said St. Helens Mining District, State aforesaid, and more particularly known and described as follows, to-wit: 1.) Discovery Claim No Two, N. W., on the Northern Lights lode; 2.) Discovery Claim No Two, N. W. on the Bump lode; 3.) Discovery Claim No Two N. W., on the Mayflower lode; 4.) Discovery Claim No Two, N. W., on the Digger lode; 5.) Discovery Claim No Two, S. E. on the Dome lode; 6.) Discovery Claim No Two, S. E. on the Recorder lode; Also all his right, title and interest and demands of whatsoever kind or nature in and to any of the lodes or veins above mentioned and belonging to the group of mining claims known as the Northern Lights group, or any of the claims located thereon. Together with all the dyes, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ore, gold, silver and metal bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the right, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appurtenant and appurteant, or therewith usually had or enjoyed; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the premises, and every part and parcel thereof.
