

Mining Deed  
R. C. & W. Lange to The Spirit Lake Power & Mining Co.

Know All Men By These Presents; That we R. C. Lange and Minnie Lange husband and wife, of Cle Elum, Lewis County, Washington, and William Lange and Julie Lange husband and wife of St. Joseph, Mo., for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar (\$1.00) to us in hand paid receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for and in consideration of Two Hundred Thousand Shares of Stock in the Spirit Lake Power and Mining Company a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Washington, issued and delivered to us by said mining company receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, transferred and conveyed and do by these presents bargain, sell, transfer, convey, assign and quit claim unto the Spirit Lake Power and Mining Company all those certain mining discoveries, claims and interests now owned and controlled by us or either of us in the St. Helens Mining District, County of Klickitat State of Washington, which said mining discoveries, interest, claims and properties are more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Northern Lights Lode, Discovery Claim, No. One S. E., described as follows: Beginning at the N. W. corner of the claim located by Geo. W. Taylor on the Blinus Lode and running thence in a Northwesterly direction 1500 linear feet to a post marked N. W. corner, and set 300 feet in Southwesterly direction from the Discovery of the above Lode; Thence Northeasterly 600 linear feet to a post marked N. E. corner; Thence Southeasterly 1500 linear feet to a post marked S. E. corner; Thence Southwesterly 600 linear feet to place of beginning. Also Northern Lights Lode, Discovery Claim, No. Two N. W., described as follows: Beginning at the N. W. corner of Discovery Claim No. One and running thence in a Northeasterly direction 1500 linear feet to a post marked N. W. corner; Thence Northeasterly 600 linear feet to a post marked N. E. corner; Thence Southeasterly 1500 linear feet to a post marked S. E. corner; Thence Southwesterly 600 linear feet to place of beginning. Also, Jupiter Lode, Discovery Claim, No. One S. E. Described as follows: Beginning at the Discovery, situated between the May flower Lode and the Dwyer Lode, at the foot of what is to be known as the "Jupiter Cliff" and running thence S. 26° E. 1500 linear feet and taking 300 linear feet on each side from the center of the Lode through the whole length of the claim. Also, Jupiter Lode, Discovery Claim, No. Two N. W. Described as follows: Beginning at the Discovery, situated between the May Flower Lode and the Dwyer Lode, at the foot of what is to be known as the "Jupiter Cliff" and running thence N. 26° W. 1500 linear feet and taking 300 linear feet on each side from the center of the Lode through the whole length of said claim. Also, Dwyer Lode, Discovery Claim, No. One S. E. Described as follows: Beginning in the center of a branch of Bayon Creek, about 300 linear feet Northeasterly of the center line of the Dwyer Lode and running thence Southeasterly 1500 linear feet to a post and taking 300 linear feet on the South side and 300 feet on the North side from the center of the Lode, joining the Dwyer Lode claim. Also, Dwyer Lode, Discovery Claim, No. Two N. W. Described as follows: Beginning in the center of a branch of Bayon Creek, about 300 feet North, easterly of the center line of the Dwyer Lode, and running thence Northwesteally
