

1500 linear feet to a post, and taking 300 linear feet on the South side and 300 linear feet on the North side from the center of the Lode, joining the Dome Lode. Also, Bijou Lode, Discovery Claim, No. Three N. W. described as follows: Beginning at Discovery No. Three about 250 feet Southeasternly from the N. W. end post of Discovery Claim No. Two of said Lode, and running thence N. W. 1500 linear feet to a post and taking 300 linear feet on each side of the center of the Lode and joining the Dome Lode including two ore streaks Westerly of the main Lode, to be known as the Phœnix and Triad ore streaks. Also, Dome Lode, Discovery Claim No One, N. W. described as follows: Beginning in the center of a branch of Bayon Creek, a tributary of Spirit Lake, about 600 feet below Dome Pass on the Divide between the head of Coldwater Valley and the Spirit Lake country, known as Game Park, and running thence Northwesterly 1500 linear feet, and taking 300 linear feet on each side from the center of said Lode. Also, Dome Lode, Discovery Claim, No. Two S. E. described as follows: Beginning in the center of a branch of Bayon Creek, a tributary of Spirit Lake, about 600 feet below Dome Pass on the Divide between the Head of Coldwater Valley and the Spirit Lake country known as Game Park, and running thence Southeasternly 1500 linear feet, and taking 300 linear feet on each side from the center of said Lode. Also Recorder Lode, Discovery Claim No. One N. W. described as follows: Beginning at the Discovery about 350 feet above the Discovery of the Dome Lode, on the same creek and running thence N. W. 1500 linear feet including 300 linear feet on each side of the Lode from the center thereof. Also, Recorder Lode, Discovery Claim, No. Two S. E. described as follows: Beginning at the Discovery about 350 feet above the Discovery of the Dome Lode, on the same creek and running thence S. E. 1500 linear feet including 300 linear feet on each side of the Lode from the center thereof. Also, Mayflower Lode, Discovery Claim, No. One S. E. described as follows: Beginning at the Discovery in the center of a branch of Bayon Creek, about 750 ft. Westerly of the Northern Lights claim, and running thence 1500 linear feet Southeasternly to a post, and taking 300 linear feet on each side from the center of Lode including two ore streaks about 25 and 50 ft. respectively Northeasternly from this lode. Also, Mayflower Lode, Discovery Claim No. Two, N. W. described as follows: Beginning at the Discovery in center of a branch of Bayon Creek, about 750 feet Westerly of the Northern Lights claim, and running thence Northwesterly 1500 linear feet to a post, and taking 300 linear feet on each side from center of lode. Including two ore streaks about 25 and 50 feet respectively Northeasternly from this lode. Also, Mayflower Lode, Discovery Claim, No. Three N. W. described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest end post of Discovery Claim No. Two N. W. on the Mayflower Lode and running thence Northwesterly 1500 linear feet to a post, and taking 300 linear feet on each side from the center of the Lode. Including two ore streaks about 25 and 50 feet respectively Northeasternly from this Lode. Also, Lamp Lode, Discovery Claim, No. One S. E. described as follows: Beginning in the center of the Creek, a branch of Bayon Creek, about 300 feet Northwesterly from the Loghouse and running thence Southeasternly 1500 linear feet to a post, and taking 300 linear feet on each side of the center of the Lode. Also, Lamp Lode, Discovery Claim,
