Hanlon of Skamania County State of Washington for the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars the following real estate in Skamania County State of Washington to wit: Commencing on the North line of the estate of William Haffey deceased at the North West corner of that portion of land set apart or apportioned out of the estate of said William Haffey deceased to Cornelius Haffey running thence South along the west line of said parcel of land or set apart or apportioned to said Cornelius Haffey as aforesaid one hundred and five (105) rods (1) one link to the North line of that portion of land set apart or apportioned out of said estate to Bernard A. Haffey thence west along said line twenty five (25) rods and (1) one link thence North parallel with said west line one hundred and five (105) rods and one (1) link to the North line of said estate thence east along said north line to place of beginning said described real estate containing fifteen and eleven hundredths (15 $\frac{11}{100}$) acres and being a portion of the the real estate of said estate of said William Haffey deceased.
