

A. A. Westall to H. W. Coe.

This Indenture, Made the 28th Day of March in the year of our Lord, one thousand, nine hundred and Three between A. A. Westall of Toledo, Lewis County State of Washington party of the first part, and Henry W. Coe party of the second part, Witnesses: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, Lawful Money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns All his right, title and interest (Individual and as a partner of A. H. Lapham) to the Lillie Quartz Claim in the St Helens Mining District, Shumner County State of Washington. Said Claim is situated North of Lewis River three fourth ($\frac{3}{4}$) of a mile from Meta Lake in a Southerly direction and about one half mile from the Touch River and one mile from Norway Pass, southerly - Said Claim adjoins the Juniatta on the Northerly End line and the Lillie Number 2 on the Southerly End line and said claim lies southerly from the Jack Pot.

Together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silverbearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the right, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profit thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

To Have and To Hold, all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part - heirs and assigns forever.
