Three years after date for value received we promise to pay to the order of J.W. Jamison five hundred dollars with interest thereon payable quarterly at the rate of eight per cent per annum from date; and if not so paid the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectable at the option of the holder of this note. If the interest is not paid when due it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest principal and interest payable in U.S. Gold Coin, and in case suit is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof we promise to pay such additional sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys fee to be taxed as a part of the cost of such suit for the use of plaintiffs Attorney.
