William M. Hillis & wife to Wm Allen.

This Indenture, Made this 10th Day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Three between William M. Hillis and Mary E. Hillis, his wife parties of the first part; and William Allen party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby Grant, Bequeath, Sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns forever, all the timber lying, standing or being upon all those tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington described as follows to-wit: Lots numbered One and Two (1&2) and the South one half of the Northeast one quarter ($\frac{1}{2}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section one (1) Township Two (2) Range six (6) East of Willamette Meridian together with the right to enter upon said land and cut and remove therefrom at any time within Twenty Five years from date hereof the timber herein conveyed, hereby granting the right to cut such other timber and make such other alterations on said land as may be required in the cutting and removal of said timber.

To Have and to Hold the Same, To the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, for and during the term aforesaid, with the exclusive right of occupancy of said land, said first parties covenanting not to enter upon said property for any purpose whatever while the herein granted timber remains uncut, and said parties of the first part, for themselves their heirs, executors and administrators, do hereby covenant with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that they are well seized in fee of the lands and premises aforesaid; that the same are free from incumbrances
