Wunder parties of the first part, for their heirs, executors and administrators, do hereby covenant with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that they well seized in fee of the lands and premises aforesaid and have good right to sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid; that the same are free from all incumbrances, and the above bargained and granted lands and premises, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof, the said parties of the first part will Warrant and Defend.
