Sealed with our seals and dated the seventh day of April one thousand nine hundred and three.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden obligors shall make, execute and deliver unto the said County of Skamania a good Warranty Deed when they receive a Deed from the State of the land to be Deeded (provided that the said County of Skamania shall, on or before that day, have paid to the said obligors the sum of Twenty Dollars, the price by said Skamania County agreed to be paid therefor) a good and sufficient conveyance, with the usual covenants, all of that certain lot or piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit,

30 feet off of the West Side of lot 1 Section 34 Township 2 North Range 6 East N. W. according to the survey made by C. V. Williams, County Surveyor, establishing said line of said lot on Mar 28: 1903; Then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
