

John Leland Henderson et al. to Tyler Woodward, Trustee.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John Leland Henderson and Marvin J. Henderson, husband and wife of the City of Hood River, County of Waia and State of Oregon; J. F. Short and Eudora Short, husband and wife, of Hood River Valley, said County and State; John D. Carey and Jennie Carey, husband and wife; and David A. McFarlane, a single man, all of the City of Halsey and State of Oregon; all parties of the first part, grantors; for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Six hundred fifteen Dollars and ten cents (\$25,615.10). To us cash in hand paid by Tyler Woodward, Trustee, of the City of Portland, State of Oregon, party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Tyler Woodward, Trustee and unto his successors, heirs and assigns forever, all of those certain tracts and parcels of land, lying, being and situate in the Little White Salmon Valley, in the County of Placer and State of Washington, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: The North half of the north half of Section One (1), containing one hundred fifty nine sixty-two hundredths acres of land, designated on the plat on file in the United States Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, as the George Tyrell claim; the south half of the north west quarter, the south west quarter of the north east quarter and the north west quarter of the south east quarter of said section one (1), containing one hundred sixty acres of land, known on said plat as the Horace Witherman claim, - excepting out of said Witherman claim recreation acres of land, owned by one Fisher and others, - leaving in the Witherman claim, conveyed by this deed, one hundred forty-three acres of land; the west half of the east half of section twelve, containing one hundred and sixty acres of land, known on said plat as the J. F. Kimball claim; the east half of the west half of said section twelve (12) containing one hundred sixty acres of land, known on said plat as the Edwin A. Blood claim; the west half of the south west quarter of said section twelve (12) containing eighty acres of land, known on said plat as the H. Schallhorn claim; the south half of the north east quarter, the northeast quarter of the north east quarter, and the north west quarter of the south east quarter of section thirteen (13), containing one hundred sixty acres of land, known on said plat as the William Ingles claim; the north half of the north west quarter, the south west quarter of the northwest quarter, and the northwest quarter of the north east quarter of section thirteen (13); containing one hundred sixty acres of land, known on said plat as the David H. Ordway claim; the south east quarter of the north west quarter, the north half of the south west quarter, and the south east quarter of the south west quarter of said section thirteen (13), containing one hundred sixty acres of land, known on said plat as the David H. Ordway claim, number two; the south half of the north east quarter of the north east quarter, and the south east quarter of the north east quarter of section fourteen (14) containing sixty (60) acres of land, known on
