

Amos Underwood to The Underwood Mining Co.

This Indenture, Made the 18th Day of July, A.D. 1903, between Amos Underwood and Ellen Underwood, husband and wife, parties of the first part, and the Underwood Mining Company, of Underwood's Landing, Skamania County, State of Washington, a Washington Corporation, duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Washington, party of the second part, Witnesseth:— That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Nineteen Hundred Dollars stock in said Corporation to them delivered, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quit claimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described placer claim, situate in Negro Head Mining District in Skamania County, State of Washington, to-wit:— Beginning at this stake running 20 rods East, thence 80 rods North, thence 40 rods West, thence 80 rods South, thence 20 rods East to place of beginning, known and located as the "Uncle Sam" Mining Claim located April 9 1903 and recorded in Skamania County records, in Book B Mineral Locations page 599.

Together with all and singular the Dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the rights, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appurtenant and appertaining, or therewith usually had and enjoyed, and also all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said parties of the first part, of, in, or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances. To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever.
