Marble to Lidstone

The East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section eight (8) in Township one (1) North of Range five (5), East of Willamette Meridian, containing twenty (20) acres more or less, to secure the payment of the sum of One hundred dollars and the interest thereon in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy, to-wit:

Vancouver, Wash May 28th 1909

Three years after date for value received I promise to pay to the order of Fred Lidstone one hundred dollars with interest thereon payable annually at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from date; and if not so paid the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectable at the option of the holder of this note. If the interest is not paid when due it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest, principal and interest payable in U.S. Gold Coin, and in case suit is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof I promise to pay such additional sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys fees to be taxes as a part of the costs of such suit for the use of plaintiffs attorney.
