

Charles E. Hill to Harry G. Hill.

This Indenture, made this twentieth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three, between Charles E. Hill, a single man of Elma, Cowlitz Co. Wash., the party of the first part, and Harry G. Hill of Elma, Cowlitz Co. Wash., party of the second part. Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred and ten Dollars lawful money of the United States, to him in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, begive, sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract, lot, or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The East  $\left(8\frac{1}{2}\right)$  half of the North West quarter  $\left(N.W.\frac{1}{4}\right)$  and lots one and two of Section  $\left(19\right)$  nineteen, Township  $\left(3\right)$  three North of Range No  $\left(9\right)$  nine East of Willamette Meridian and containing one hundred fifty nine and twelve hundredths  $\left(159\frac{12}{100}\right)$  acres. Together with the appurtenances, to have and to hold the said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said party of the first part & his heirs, executors and administrators, does by these presents, covenant, grant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, & his heirs and assigns, that he, the said party of the first part, his heirs, executors and administrators, all and singular, the premises hereinabove conveyed, described and granted, or mentioned, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, and against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof shall and will warrant and forever defend.
