

Wm Hostetler & wife to Wm Danson.

This Indenture, made the 31st Day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three, between Wm Hostetler and Edna Hostetler, husband and wife, the parties of the first part, and William Danson of the County of Cook and State of Illinois, the party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, gold coin of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quit-claimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, That certain mining claim in St. Helens Mining District, Stannum County, Wash., known as the "Kangaroo" otherwise called "Bankroo" as located by Wm Hostetler, also the "Statlope" or "Statelope" in said District, County and State, both of said claims lying about one mile northeast of Spirit Lake and located Dec. 5. 1902 and more particularly described in notice of location filed with Auditor of said County Febr. 5. 1903 and recorded in record of Mining Claims of said County in Vol. B page 270.

Together with all the dikes, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz rock and earth therein, and all the rights, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed, and also, all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof, and also, all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim or demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said part--- of the first part, of, in to or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

To Have and to Hold, all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges therunto incident, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
