Know all men by these Presents: That I, Ebent T. Skar, of Stevenson, Washington, in consideration of one Dollar  $(\$1.00)$  the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, am firmly bound unto J. R. Kee in the sum of  $\$250.00$  in U.S. Gold Coin, to be paid to said J. R. Kee, for which payment I bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators. Dated this 7th Day of October A.D. 1903. The conditions of the above obligation are such, that whences I, the said Ebent T. Skar have this day sold to J. R. Kee the following land, to-wit:

The South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the East  $\frac{1}{2}$  of South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$ , all of Section 26 Township 3 North Range 7 E. W. M. containing thirty  $(30)$  acres, for the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars  $(\$250.00)$ , and whences the said J. R. Kee has paid the sum of fifty Dollars  $(\$50.00)$  of said purchase price; Now Therefore, whences said J. R. Kee has paid the balance of said purchase price, being the sum of Two hundred  $(\$200.00)$  Dollars, I will deliver to said J. R. Kee, or his heirs and executors, a good and lawful Warranty Deed for said real estate above mentioned, providing that the last payment on said purchase price is not later than June 30th. 1904.
