Know All Men By These Presents, that I, J. C. Day Jr., unmarried, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.) to me in hand paid by The Skamania Room Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal office and place of business at Vancouver, in the State of Washington, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said corporation, The Skamania Room Company, and unto its successors and assigns, all the timber on the East half of the Southwest quarter, and lots three (3) and four (4) of Section thirty (30), in Township three (3) North of Range eight (8) East of the Willamette Meridian; and also the right to enter into and upon the same for the purpose of removing said timber and the construction and maintenance of a logging road thereon forever. The intention being to grant to said corporation, The Skamania Room Company, all the rights and privileges reserved by myself, my heirs and assigns, in a certain deed made by me to J. F. Sweeney on September 8th, 1900, which said deed was, on the 28th day of May, 1901, recorded in Book C. of Deeds, page 333, in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, State of Washington.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all my estate, right, title and interest in and to the same.

To Have And To Hold the same unto the said corporation The Skamania Room Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
