The South half of the South half of the Southeast quarter of Section One (1) and the North east quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section Twelve (12) in Township three (3) North, Range Nine (9), East, Willamette Meridian, containing eighty (80) acres of land, according to the United States plats and surveys, together with the all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all our estate, right title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claims of dower.
