

bank of Rock Creek; running thence down Rock Creek Treaty 207 feet South of its Southbank to the Southline of the Northwestquarter of Southwest quarter of said Section Thirty-six (36); thence East to the middle of Rock Creek; thence up middle of Rock Creek to a point Five (5) chains West of the Eastline of said Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-six (36) said Township and Range; thence North to Northline of said Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of said Section thirty-six (36); thence west to point of beginning. It is the intention of the grantor to convey all the land in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section thirty-six (36) owned by him north of Treaty (20) feet South of Southbank of Rock Creek.

Also, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of Rock Creek on the South line of Section Thirty-six (36) in Township Three (37) North of Range Seven (77) East of Willamette Meridian; running thence west to the line between the East half and the West half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section Thirty-six (36); thence North to the center of Rock Creek; thence down the center of Rock Creek to the point of beginning. The Grantors intend hereby to convey all the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest quarter of said section Thirty-six (36) that lies and is situated on the west side of the center of Rock Creek.

The grantors and their assigns while they own land in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), or acquire title to the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-five (35) in said Township and Range, reserve the free use of a wagon road on the high bank on the west side of said premises of sufficient width for their ordinary traffic. To have and to hold the same, all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, to the said Wind River Lumber Company and to its heirs and assigns forever.
