

the remainder of said estate in fee simple to the children of the said Christiana Hagg who shall be living at the time of her decease, but in case the said Christiana Hagg shall not leave any children surviving her, then the above granted premises shall revert to the grantors herein, their heirs and assigns.

And the said Jacob Bauerle and Susannah Bauerle, his wife, grantors above named, do covenant with the said Christiana Hagg and her assigns, and her children who shall survive her, their heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises; that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, and that they will and their heirs and assigns executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
