And we, Edward Underwood and Isabel Underwood grantors above named do covenant to and with W. F. Cash, the above named grantee, his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances whatsoever, and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
