W. A. Woodruff to S. L. Marble.

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two and $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to us in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract, lot, or parcel of land, situate lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot No Eleven (11) in Mt Pleasant Cemetery, Skamania County State of Washington,

Together with the appurtenances, to have and to hold the said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said parties of the first part, Their heirs, executors and administrators, do by these presents covenant, and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns that they the said parties of the first part are the owners in fee simple of the above granted and described premises and that the same is free from all encumbrances whatsoever
