Sampson, his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington: South East quarter of South East quarter of Section twenty-one (21) in Township Two (2) North of Range Six (6) East, Willamette Meridian, containing forty (40) acres of land, more or less, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all their estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower. To have and to hold The above described and granted premises unto the said Rufus L. Sampson, his heirs and assigns forever. And the grantors above named do covenant to and with the above named grantees, his heirs and assigns, that they will, and their heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the acts and deeds of said grantors, and all persons claiming by, from, through or under the said grantors, unto the said grantees, his heirs and assigns forever.
