Inman the above named grantee, his heirs and assigns, that they are the owners in fee simple of the above granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, and that they will and their heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
