This Indenture, made this 25. day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four, Between John Kanekelberg and wife, Betsy Kanekelberg of Lowell Snohomish Co. Wash the party of the first part, and Nellie S. Mann the party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One  $\$100.00$  hundred Dollars, of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns, all that certain tract, lot or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:

South half of South East quarter of Section twenty-six in Township Three North of Range eight East of Willamette Meridian; Together with, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining. To Have and to Hold, the said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever.
