

The North half of South East quarter of Section Twenty-six is Township three North of Range eight East of Willamette Meridian in Washington, containing eighty ~~807~~ acres; Together with, all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.
