

Jack Connors to Chicago Golden Brown Mining Co.

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Jack Connors in consideration of 5000 Shares Chicago Golden Brown Mining Stock and one hundred Dollars to him paid by the Chicago Golden Brown Mining Company, do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said Chicago Golden Brown Mining Company and unto their heirs and assigns all his right title and interest in and to the following described quartz Mining claims situate in County of Skamania State of Washington, to wit: Two Mining claims described as follows:

Adjoining Chicago Golden property on the East and known as Slegjitans No (1) and No (2). Slegjitans No(1) commencing at Discovery on East branch of Devils Slide creek and running south east (300) feet, thence west (650) feet, to Chicago Golden Brown East side line, thence six hundred feet northwest to post, thence (1250) feet East to post, thence (300) feet south east to place of beginning. Slegjitans No(2) commencing at Discovery east branch of Devil Slide creek and running south east (300) feet, thence east (1500) feet to stake, thence northwest (600) feet to Blazed Tree, thence west (1500) feet to post, thence south east (300) feet to place of beginning.
