

Noel Mc. Intire to Wm Hambroes, Trustee.

This Indenture, Made the 11th Day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four between Noel Mc. Intire party of the first part and William Hambroes, Trustee the party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand five hundred < \$2500 > Dollars legal money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remise, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns: The following described mining property, to-wit:- That certain Mining Claim known as 'Royal Flush' Discovery < No 1 > number one; also 'Royal Flush' Northwest extension < No 27 > number Two, both being located in the St. Helens Mining District Skamania County and State of Washington, and being more fully and particularly described by location notices recorded on the official record at Stevenson in the above named County and State; see Record of Mining Locations Vol. "C" page 72 and 73 - June 14th 1904.

Together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the privileges, rights and franchises thereto incident, appurtenant and appertaining, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claims and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

To have and to hold, the all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
