

in and to all water rights, rights-of-way, flumes and ditches on, over or across said lands, or any part thereof, or appurtenant thereto.

To Have And To Hold the same, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to the said John Leland Henderson and J. F. Thorp, and to their heirs and assigns forever.

The grantor reserves however from the foregoing conveyance all personal property, including poles, cordwood, machinery, logging tools, brick and iron which may be upon any of said tracts; also the right to the use, for a reasonable time, of the flume running across portions of said land, for the purpose of fluming to the Columbia river any wood or poles upon any of said premises belonging to said grantor, and the right to enter without let or hindrance any of said premises, for a reasonable time, for the purpose of fluming said wood or poles, and removing said machinery, tools, brick and iron.
