Emil Geitfuchs wife to H. E. Noble.

This Indenture made the 24th day of April, 1902, between Emil Geitfuchs and Tillie Geitfuchs, wife of said Emil Geitfuchs, of the City of Wallace, County of Othello, State of Idaho, the parties of the first part, and H. E. Noble, of Portland, Oregon, the party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and fifty dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever the southeast quarter of section thirty four (34), in Township three (3), north, of range six (6), East of the Willamette Meridian, being one hundred and sixty acres, more or less, in Skamania County, State of Washington; together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof.

To Have and To Hold all and singular the above mentioned and described premises, in the quiet peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against the said parties of the first part, and their heirs, and against all and every person and persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, shall and will warrant, and by these presents forever defend
