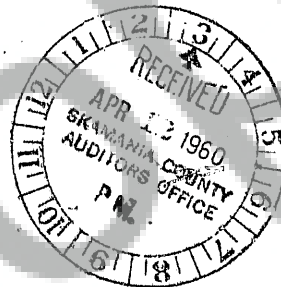
## CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 127, Laws of Washington for 1927, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that CARL EISEN  
 of Cook, State of Washington, has made  
 proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use  
 of the waters of Squaw Creek, a tributary of Little White Salmon River,  
 with point or points of diversion within the E<sub>2</sub> of Lot 3 Oregon Lumber Co. Subdivision  
 Sec. 14, Twp. 3 N., R. 9 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in  
Appropriation Permit No. 11715 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and  
 that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,  
 and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of  
 record in Volume 16, at Page 7775, on the 11th day of April, 1960,  
 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is October 20, 1959; that the  
 amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount  
 actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 of a cubic foot per second  
for community domestic supply.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the  
 place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

E<sub>2</sub> of Lot 3 of Oregon Lumber Co. Subdivision in  
sec. 14, T.3N., R. 9 E.W.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of  
 use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
