This Indenture made this third day of November 1909 between Harriet Turner, a widow, of Skamania County Washington, party of the first part, and Bank of Stevenson a corporation of Washington, party of the second part witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and no/100 dollars lawful money of the United States to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey and warranty unto the said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington and particularly described as follows:

Lots nine (9) and ten (10) of Section twenty-four and Lots three (3) four (4) and nine (9) of Section twenty-five (25) Township three (3) North of Range seven and one half (7½) East of Willamette meridian. Against which property there is now outstanding a certain mortgage for two hundred dollars made by Harriet Turner to Bank of Stevenson, bearing date July 21st 1909 to which mortgage this is subject and secondary. , together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) lawful money of the United States, together with interest thereon at the rate of ten per cent per annum from date until paid according to the terms and conditions of a certain promissory note bearing date November 3rd 1909 made and executed by Harriet Turner payable ## one year after date to the order of Bank of Stevenson, and these presents shall be void if such payment be made according to the terms and conditions thereof.
