12 CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 122, Laws of Washington for 1929, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Department of Water Resources (hereinafter).

This is to certify that PACIFIC POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

of Portland, State of Oregon, has made
 proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
 of the waters of North Fork Lewis River, a tributary of Columbia River
 with point or points of diversion within the S1NW1 and N1SW1

Sec. 28, Twp. 7 N., R. 5 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in
 Reservoir R-200
 Appropriation Permit No. 10214 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and

that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
 and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
 record in Volume 10, at Page 7890, on the 7th day of September, 1960.
 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is December 17, 1954; that the
 amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
 actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2600 cubic feet per second under Permit No. 10214
 for the purpose of power development and 740,000 acre-feet per year under Reservoir
 Permit No. 200 to be stored and used for the purpose of power development.

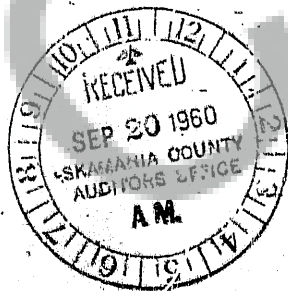
A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
 place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Swift #1 Plant

Lots 4 and 5 of Sec. 28, T. 7 N., R. 5 E.W.M., Skamania County

Swift #2 Plant

Lot 1 of Sec. 25, T. 7 N., R. 4 E.W.M., Cowlitz County



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
