(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 22, Laws of 1929, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources.)

This is to certify that

WATER AND LANDS, INC.

of Carson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Flyn Spring Creek, a tributary of Kinn River with point or points of diversion within the SEATTLE Sec. 23, Twp. 3 N., R. 6 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 7953 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 6, at Page 7913, on the 27th day of September, 1960, that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is November 9, 1951; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 of a cubic foot per second for domestic supply and 0.19 of a cubic foot per second, 30 acre-feet per year, for the irrigation of 15 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

SEATTLE, Sec. 23, T. 3 N., R. 6 E. W. M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 22, Laws of 1929.
