

after the same shall become due and payable or to conform or to comply with any of the foregoing covenants and conditions then at the election of the party of the second part, as provided by law these presents, shall forthwith become due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed immediately and a decree had to sell said premises according to law and out of the money arising from such sale shall be paid said principal sum, with interest costs and charges and all moneys secured hereby, together with an attorneys fee of five per cent of the amount found to be due upon such sums with interest.

Fifth. It is hereby expressly stipulated and agreed by and between the parties hereto their heirs executors administrators or assigns, that in case of a foreclosure of this mortgage that party of the second part his heirs executors or assigns shall be entitled to have entered in such foreclosure suit a judgment for any deficiency remaining due upon account of the indebtedness secured hereby, including taxes insurance or other lawful assessments, after applying the proceeds of the sale of the premises above described to the payment thereof and to the costs of such foreclosure suit and attorneys fee.

Sixth. And it is further stipulated and agreed between the parties hereto their heirs executors administrators or assigns that in case of foreclosure of this mortgage at any sale hereunder the purchaser thereof shall be entitled to the immediate possession of the premises so sold whether or not the same are then occupied as a homestead.
