CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 127, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that EDGAR R. CADEAU

of Washougal, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of West Fork Washougal River, with point or points of diversion within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 20, Twp. 2 N., R. 5 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 7357 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 12, at Page 5116, on the 26th day of May, 1954, that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is March 15, 1951, that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed

0.92 of a cubic foot per second for the purposes of
power, domestic supply and the irrigation of 2 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 20, Twp. 2 N., Rge. 5 E.W.M. and
the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 20, Twp. 2 N., Rge. 5 E.W.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
