present does grant, bargain, sell, remove, release, convey and quitclaim unto the said party

in all the right, title and interest, estate, claim and demands of said party of the first part,
of, in and to that certain portion, claim and mining right, title and property in the
Portland certain ledge, vein, rock or deposits of quartz and other rock in place, containing
