This Indenture made this 5th day of January in the year of our Lord 1910 between John F. Sweeney and Mary E. Sweeney his wife of Stevenson Washington, parties of the first part, and E.C. Gillett of Carson, Washington, party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and no/100 dollars lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey and warrant unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described real property lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter and lots numbered five and six in Section thirty-one in Township three North of Range eight East of Willamette Meridian, excepting therefrom a strip of land heretofore deeded to the Spokane Portland & Seattle Ry.
