

W. W. O'Conner to S. A. Sessions.

This Indenture, made this 18th Day of March A. D. 1905, by and between W. W. O'Conner, of Lewis County, Washington, party of the first, and S. A. Sessions, in his own right, and as trustee for J. M. Gray, W. A. Gray, S. W. Livingston, R. Palitzsch, A. R. Zeller and J. F. Boone, party of the second part, Witnesseth, That said party of the first party in consideration of One Dollar, paid to said party of the first part, by said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, sold, quitclaimed and released and by these presents does bargain, sell, release and quit claim, unto said S. A. Sessions in his own right and as trustee for said parties and his successors and assigns, all the right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand of the said party of the first part, the following described tracts, lots, or parcels of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: That certain mining claim called Germania Secundus Discovery No. 2 Lode, certificate of location of which is recorded in Book B of Mineral Locations, page 488, Auditor's Office of said Skamania County, Washington, and also Germania Secundus Discovery No. 1 Lode, certificate of location for which is recorded in said Auditor's office in Book B of Mineral Locations page 486, and to which certificates reference is made for the facts and description of the said claims, and same are made a part of this deed. This deed is made for the purpose of relinquishing any right I might appear to have because said certificates show my name to be signed to same as locator and claimant, which is a mistake, I having posted the notice of location only for the said Germania Mining and Milling Co. and not as locator or claimant. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions and reversion, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof. To Have and to Hold the above quit claimed premises, with all and singular the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
