McLeod, the party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for the sum of one (\$1.00) dollar and other valuable consideration to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted, bargained sold, released, released all former quitclaim, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns: an undivided one third ( $\frac{1}{3}$  rd) interest in the following mining claims to-wit: The Palmer, Jackson Park and Arcade; the Lincoln Park and Clarke and the Mazzyea No. 1 and Mazzyea No. 2, all being Lode mining claims and situated in the St. Helens Mining District, Skamania County and State of Washington and being more particularly described as recorded on the official records of said County and State.

Together with all the diggs, guns and eagles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the rights, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said parties of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

To Have and to Hold, all and singular the said premises together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
