

Geo. B. Olmstead to Wind River Lumber Co.

The Grantors, Geo. B. Olmstead and Anna Olmstead his wife, residing at Carson, Skamania County, Washington, for and in consideration of three hundred Dollars in hand paid, convey and warrant to the Wind River Lumber Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate, situated in Skamania County, Washington, to wit:

All of Lot Four (4) and all of Lot Five (5) lying and being on the West side of the center of Wind River in Section Seven (7) in Township Three (3) North of Range eight (8) East of Willamette Meridian, also all that part of the North East quarter of the South West quarter of said Section Seven said Township and range which lies and is situated on the West side of the center of said Wind River. Also granting unto said Wind River Lumber Company its successors and assigns the right and privileges to enter upon the east bank of said Wind River in said Section for the purpose of dislodging and removing any and all logs and timber products that may hereafter be lodged or stranded on the banks of said stream, together with the right and privilege to drive logs and other timber products down said river across said section Seven, and to impound the waters of said stream and release the same in artificial floods for the purpose of increasing the flow of said stream.
