Douglass of same place, party of the second part, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described real property situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

(Beginning at a point which is four and forty hundredths <4.40> chains North of the South-east corner of Lot six <6> of Section one <1> in Township Two <2> North of Range seven <7> East of W. M.; from thence West four and fifty-five hundredths <4.55> chains; thence North five and fifty hundredths <5.50> chains; thence East four and fifty-five hundredths <4.55> chains; thence South along the west line of Henry Shepard S.
