Know all men by these Presents, That I, Frank Marble and Clara F Marble his wife, of the County of Skamania and State of Washington, are held and firmly bound unto Earl L Marble of the County and State aforesaid in the sum of one thousand dollars law full money of the United States, for the payment of whereof, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and our executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 30. day of August 1904.

The condition of the above obligation is that if the above bounden Frank Marble and Clara F Marble shall on or before five years after date of this Bond make and deliver unto Earl L. Marble a good and sufficient Warranty Deed provided that the said Earl L Marble shall on or before that day have paid to the obligors the sum of five hundred dollars lawful money of the United States. And it is further provided and agreed to by the above named Obligor that when this five hundred dollars or any part of it is paid that it is to be applied on a certain mortgage held by Gus Kruckman, The above described five hundred dollars is the price agreed upon for the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in Skamania County, Washington and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit: The East half of the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section eighteen (18) Township one (1) North Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing twenty (20) acres of land,

Then this obligation shall become and thenceforth be void, otherwise to be and remain of full force and virtue.
