 of the waters of Tyee Springs, a tributary of Wind River
 located North 28°27' West 9462 feet from the North Quarter Corner
 with 1st or points of diversion/intersection of Sec. 9; also, North 78°45' East 2008 feet from the
 State Highway (8-C) bridge over Wind River, being within Unsurveyed
 Twp. 5 N., R. 7 E., W. 2 E. under and subject to provisions contained in
 Appropriation Perm. No. 9025 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and
 that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
 and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
 record in Volume 12, at Page 5754, on the 3rd day of September, 1954
 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is January 12, 1953; that the
 amount of water under the right hereby confirmed for the following purposes is limited to an amount
 actually beneficially used and shall not exceed

2.0 cubic feet per second for the purposes
of domestic supply and fish culture.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
 place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Carson Fish Cultural Station in unsurveyed Twp. 5 N.,
Rgs. 7 E.M.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or
 use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
