Brather, his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, to-wit: The North half of the N.E. quarter and the S.W. quarter of the N.W. quarter of Section 15 in Township 3 North of Range 10 East W.M., containing 120 acres, more or less, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all our estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower. To have and to hold the above described and granted premises unto the said George T. Brather, his heirs and assigns forever. And we, William Kellendroff and Catharine Lucy Kellendroff, grantors above named do covenant to and with George T. Brather, the above named grantee and his heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all encumbrances and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomever.
