And in any suit or other proceedings that may be had for the recovery of said principal sum and interest on either said note or this mortgage, it shall and may be lawful for the said party of the second part her heirs executors and assigns to include in the judgment that may be recovered, cousel feee and charges of attorneys and cousle employed in such foreclosure suit the sum of blank dollars in gold coin of the United States, as well as all payments that the said party of the second part her heirs executors or assigns may be obliged to make for her own or their security by insurance or on account of any taxes, charges, incumbrances or assessments whatsoever on the said premises or any part thereof.
