

Henry Blankenship to Mc Boy Creek Mfg Co.

This Indenture, made the 21st day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five, between Henry Blankenship of Rosalia, Lewis County, Washington, the party of the first part, and Mc Boy Creek Mining Company, the party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to him as here paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part and to their heirs and assigns, the following mining claims: The Portland quartz mine, located by me on June 3^d 1904 situated on Mc Boy Creek in Skamania County, Washington, and recorded on Sept 1st 1904 in Book C of Mining Locations page 129, Records of Skamania County, Wash.

The Golden Spike Mine, located April 13th 1905, situated on Mc Boy Creek Skamania Co. Wash. recorded in Book C of Mineral Locations page 300, Records, Skamania County, Wash.

The Lourie Mine. Located April 25th 1905 and situated on Mc Boy Creek in Skamania County, Wash. and recorded June 13th 1904 in Book B Mineral Locations page 603, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

Bimetallic No 2. Situate on Mc Boy Creek in Skamania County, Wash. Located on April 19th 1905 and recorded in Book C of Mineral Locations page 310 on July 14th 1905 Records of Skamania County, Washington. Together with all and singular the days, years and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the rights, privileges and franchises thereto incident, apparent and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also, all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also, all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the said premises and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances thereto belonging. To Have and to Hold, all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever.
