

T. A. Beall to St. Helens Ore Mill & Power Co.

This Indenture Witnesseth, That I, T. A. Beall of Lewiston Illinois, party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, in currency of the United States of America to me in hand paid by St. Helens Ore Mill and Power Company, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has remised, released and forever quit-claimed, and by these presents do sell, remise, release, and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part and to their heirs and assigns, the following described Water Location, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The Notice for the Waterright is posted about 1500 feet from the actual outlet of Spirit Lake (Some times called St. Helens Lake) about four and one half miles slightly East from Mt St. Helens on the Toutle River. The Water claimed hereby is in amount of about 20000 cubic feet per second of time, and it is the purpose to divert at this point to some place about 500 feet of the County line between Bonville and Skamania Counties and being within Skamania County, State of Washington and about 2000 feet from the Toutle River. To have and to hold the said premises, with all their appurtenances unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns forever.
