B. F. Beals to Columbia Ry & Nav. Co.

Right of Way Deed.

The Grantor, Benj. F. Beals, widower, of Skamania County, Washington, in consideration of Fifty and 00/100 Dollars, now paid, grants and conveys to Columbia Railway & Navigation Company a Washington corporation, the real property situate in Skamania County, State of Washington, described as follows: A strip of land one hundred feet in width, over and across lot two (2), section twenty-nine (29) in Township three (3) North of Range Ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian, said strip of land being fifty (50) feet in width on each side of the center line of the main track of said Grantor's railroad, as the same is now or may hereafter be located and staked out over and across said premises, together with the right to take the necessary earth and stone from adjacent land for the purpose of constructing the railroad of said company across said premises.

Said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damages sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad on, over and across said described land.
